

Ladies Event Descriptions - 2018

League

Tuesdays - May 1 – September 19 (excluding July 17 and August 28)

Our league is a team event, occurring on Tuesdays. Teams are randomly assigned by computer program, taking handicaps into account. Each Tuesday, ladies make their own tee time and play 9 holes with whoever they want. Score cards will no longer be printed each week. Ladies should pick up a score card in the pro shop each week and keep their gross score along with gross par points for each hole (100% handicap will be used in calculating the net par points). If assistance is needed, the pro shop staff will take care of it – just keep the gross score. Depending on the size of the teams for the year, the best 3-4 par point scores per team will be counted each week. There are no subs or make ups for missed weeks due to absence or weather. Most ladies play sometime between noon-1 or 3-4, but league is not limited to those times. Each week, ladies can opt in to the weekly sweeps game, which will be posted in the pro shop at the start of the season (i.e. most fairways hit, least putts, highest par points, and other fun games).

Birdies

Tuesdays - May 1 – September 19 (excluding July 17 and August 28)

Keep track of any gross birdies you get all year on league day.

- Any time you get a birdie during the 9-hole round on league day, simply fill out the Birdie form in the Birdie envelope in the pro shop.
- Birdies will be tallied throughout the league season.
- Everyone who joins the birdie tree gets a prize at the end of the season.

REMINDER: Birdies are tracked only on league days for the 9-holes assigned for league that week. If you decide to play 18-holes on Tuesday and get a birdie on the opposite 9, it does not count towards birdies. Birdies are not counted during guest days or any other time outside of the 9-hole league. It was voted in fall of 2017 to go to this method because it makes it a perfectly equal playing field for everyone (all ladies play the exact same number of holes during the duration of league).

Ringers

Tuesdays - May 1 – September 19 (excluding July 17 and August 28)

Also known as "Your Ultimate Round". The Ringer Score is composed of the very best you've ever shot on each hole. The season-long Ringer Tournament is your lowest gross score on each of the 9 holes on league day. It's fun to see how you improve throughout the year!

- The first league day, simply fill out the Ringer form in the Ringer envelope in the pro shop with your gross score for every hole. This will only be a 9-hole score.

- The second week of league, fill out the Ringer form with the other 9-hole score. After these two weeks, you should now have a full/combined 18-hole score.
- Every league day thereafter, only record your improved gross scores on the Ringer form. The values for each hole never increase. They either remain the same or shrink round after round after round.

First Combined 18-hole Round:

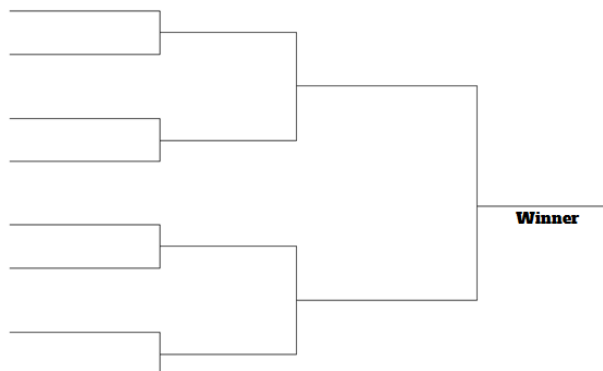
REMINDER: Ringers are tracked only on league days for the 9-holes assigned for league that week. If you decide to play 18-holes on Tuesday you do not record the second 9 for Ringers. Ringers are not counted during guest days or any other time outside of the 9-hole league. It was voted in fall of 2017 to go to this method because it makes it a perfectly equal playing field for everyone (all ladies play the exact same number of holes during the duration of league).

VP Cup

Season long event – schedule based on pairings

This is a season long match play event. The event provides 100% handicap and is an 18-hole match play event based on the *net* score on each hole. At the beginning of the season, brackets will be created by computer. The 18-hole match is played between the two competitors at their convenience, any day, at any time (within the timeframe provided for that particular bracket). The pro shop will generate the score card but needs to know ahead of time when the match is being played. The winner of each match will advance in the bracket to the next round, until the final match is completed.

Example:



Invitational

Sunday, June 10 – 1pm shotgun

Invite 1 to 3 guests to play in this event. Format is normally a 2 of 4 net best ball. We have a light lunch before play, tee gift, dinner, and prizes. This is our “biggest” of the guest events and we like to base it on a different theme each year to make it fun. Prizes are awarded to at least 25% of the field.

Guest Days

July 17 & August 28 – 1pm shotgun

Invite 1 to 3 guests to play in this event. Format varies and is chosen by the tournament chair/committee for the year. A meal follows play with awarding of prizes to at least 25% of the field.

Member-Member

July 7 & 8

Pick a partner for this member-member tournament. Format is 2 girl net best ball and is played over two days. Friday night starts with pari-mutuel betting on the men’s and ladies 2 person teams, along with dinner. 25% of the field is awarded prizes.

Couples Swap

August 5 – 11am shotgun

New this year!! Register as a couple for this two person fun event. The pro shop will randomly draw another couple to partner with. For the event the couples will swap so that they play with someone other than their spouse or significant other or friend.

Club Championship

August 25 & 26 – am tee times

This end of summer tournament is a two-day event determining the champion of the club for the season. Overall winner is based on gross score. Other winners based on net score. Light snacks are provided during the day. Awards are presented at the year-end dinner.
