Ladies Event Descriptions - 2023

<u>League</u> – Tuesdays - May 2 – September 19 (excluding July 11 and August 15)

Our league is a team event, occurring on Tuesdays. Teams are randomly assigned by computer program, taking handicaps into account. Each Tuesday, ladies make their own tee time and play 9 holes with whoever they want. Score cards will no longer be printed each week. Ladies should pick up a score card in the pro shop each week and keep their gross score along with gross par points for each hole (100% handicap will be used in calculating the net par points). If assistance is needed, the pro shop staff will take care of it – just keep the gross score. Depending on the size of the teams for the year, the best 3-4 par point scores per team will be counted each week. There are no subs or make ups for missed weeks due to absence or weather. Most ladies play sometime between noon-1 or 3-5, but league is not limited to those times. Each week, ladies can opt in to the weekly sweeps game, which will be posted in the pro shop at the start of the season (i.e. most fairways hit, least putts, highest par points, and other fun games).

<u>Birdies</u> – Tuesdays - May 2 – September 19 (excluding July 11 and August 15) Keep track of any gross birdies you get all year on league day.

All you need to do is turn your scorecard in to the pro shop each week and they will take care of the tracking for you! Make sure you circle any birdies on your card.

- Birdies will be tallied throughout the league season.
- Everyone who joins the birdie tree gets a prize at the end of the season.

REMINDER: Birdies are tracked only on league days for the 9-holes assigned for league that week. If you decide to play 18-holes on Tuesday and get a birdie on the opposite 9, it does not count towards birdies. Birdies are not counted during guest days or any other time outside of the 9-hole league.

Ringers – Tuesdays - May 2 – September 19 (excluding July 11 and August 15)

Also known as "Your Ultimate Round". The Ringer Score is composed of the very best you've ever shot on each hole. The season-long Ringer Tournament is your lowest gross score on each of the <u>9 holes on league day</u>. It's fun to see how you improve throughout the year!

All you need to do is turn your scorecard in to the pro shop each week and they will take care of the tracking for you!

REMINDER: Ringers are tracked only on league days for the 9-holes assigned for league that week. If you decide to play 18-holes on Tuesday, you do not record the second 9 for Ringers. Ringers are not counted during guest days or any other time outside of the 9-hole league.

VP Cup – Season long event – schedule based on pairings

This is a season long match play event. All VP cup matches will be played with 100% handicap off the low handicap player. At the beginning of the season, brackets will be created by computer. The 18hole match is played between the two competitors at their convenience, any day, at any time (within the timeframe provided for that particular bracket). The pro shop will generate the score card but needs to know ahead of time when the match is being played. The winner of each match will advance in the bracket to the next round, until the final match is completed.

Example:



<u>Invitational</u> – Sunday, June 25 – 1pm shotgun

Invite 1 to 3 guests to play in this event. Format is normally a 2 of 4 net best ball. We have a light lunch before play, tee gift, dinner, and prizes. This is our "biggest" of the guest events and we like to base it on a different theme each year to make it fun. Prizes are awarded to at least 25% of the field.

Guest Days – July 11 & August 15– 1pm shotgun

Invite 1 to 3 guests to play in this event. Format varies and is chosen by the tournament chair/committee for the year. One will be a scramble. A meal follows play with awarding of prizes to at least 25% of the field.

Member-Member – July 22 & 23

Pick a partner for this member-member tournament. Format is 2 girl net best ball and is played over two days. Friday night starts with pari-mutuel betting on the men's and ladies 2 person teams, along with dinner. 25% of the field is awarded prizes.

Senior Club Championship – July 8 & 9

Two-day event for women 50+. Overall winner is based on gross score. Other winners based on net score.

Club Championship – September 2 & 3 – am tee times

This end of summer tournament is a two-day event determining the champion of the club for the season. Overall winner is based on gross score. Other winners based on net score.
